Problem



Excessive time loss editing existing documents

Real Case:

A Client have contract model to be printed daily and one employee to edit these contracts with information in the ERP.

This is a massive job, with a large number of contracts in a day, spending a lot of time from the employee.

Solution



To solve the exposed case, i've idealize a model that works with the existing structure of print format, the context syntax and a "simple" docx file.

These model, gives to the final user a simple way to edit the layout and simplify the work.



Solution in Numbers



Considering these numbers:

- 10 minutes per contract
- 10 contracts per day
- 1:40h per day per employee;
- 8:20h (one day) per weak lost;
- In one month ,4 days; In a year, one month and half lost in a task that can be automatable;
